The honour board was "lost" for a number of years and found late last year by the school Chaplain, Mr Andrew Paul. A decision was made to continue the award, 20 years after it was last made. It is for a student making a significant contribution in the areas of music and art, subjects that Andrew Davis enjoyed.

We are seeking expressions of interest from people interested in undertaking an Assistant in Nursing Traineeship in 2013.

WA Health is working with Central Institute of Technology to prepare people to work with nurses in Perth hospitals. Our traineeship offers a mix of classroom work and on-the-job training. Students who complete the six-month full-time program will receive a Certificate III in Health Service Assistance (Acute Care) and will be eligible to apply for employment in an acute care setting (hospital) as an Assistant in Nursing.

Eligibility for the traineeship includes:

- be an Australian citizen or have permanent residency status at the time of application.
- have a year 10 secondary school education or equivalent.
- be prepared to commit to completing a six-month (26 week) full-time competency based training program. The program includes a mix of theory in the class room and clinical practice learning time in the hospital wards.
- be available to do shift work.
- be prepared to sit a basic Literacy Assessment prior to being shortlisted for interview.
- be willing to undergo a Working with Children Check and Criminal Record Screening clearance.


