#### **NATIONAL SELF-DETECTION PROGRAM FOR SCOLIOSIS (NSDP)**

Scoliosis (spinal curvature) is an important health problem for adolescent girls and 25 per thousand are at risk of developing a significant curve. Three girls per thousand require active treatment (spinal brace or surgery). Because in the early stages the condition is often asymptomatic, screening in the age range 11-13 years is a sound preventable health measure. When school screening for scoliosis was abandoned the Self-Detection Program as a practical alternative.

July and August are the months when it is recommended that parents with girls in Years 7 & 9 participate in the NSDP by downloading the Self Detection Brochure for Scoliosis, by going to the link on the Scoliosis Australia website [www.scoliosis-australia.org](http://www.scoliosis-australia.org).
